

THE CONNECTION SCHOOL OF HOUSTON UNIFORM & DRESS CODE POLICY

(Updated August 2016)

The Connection School of Houston uniform policy is guided by 1 Peter 3:3-4 and 1 Corinthians 6:19-20:

“Do not let your adorning be external – the braiding of hair and the putting on of gold jewelry or the clothing you wear – but let your adorning be the hidden person of the heart with the imperishable beauty of a gentle and quiet spirit, which in God’s sight is very precious.”

“Or do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit within you, whom you have from God? You are not your own, for you were bought with a price. So glorify God in your body.”

GENERAL COMMENTS:

- It is the intent of our school uniform dress code policy to train students to dress in a neat, orderly, appropriate, and safe manner so that they are ready to learn and successfully carry out the varied activities of the school day.
- The Connection School of Houston Uniform and Dress Code Policy addresses the following types of dress: Chapel Dress, Regular Dress, Friday Dress, PE Dress.
- Dress code for school field trips will be designated and communicated by the coordinating teacher before each field trip.
- Land’s End is the school’s approved uniform provider and our school uniform styles and colors are based on their items. Ordering information is available on the last page of this uniform policy.
- Uniform items, with the exception of the Girls’ clear plaid jumpers or clear plaid skirts, may be purchased from any store that matches Land’s End designs, style and colors.
- Land’s End and EmbroidMe, Cypress (<http://embroidme-cypresstx.com/> 832-653-5560) are the school’s only approved monogramming providers for school uniforms. Monogrammed uniform items are optional, with the exception of outerwear items to be worn in class.
- “Outerwear” described in this policy is descriptive of sweaters, jackets, coats, etc. that are acceptable to be worn inside the classroom. All outerwear that is worn inside the classroom must be monogrammed and coordinate in color and style according to this policy. Heavy winter coats may be of personal color and style preference, but may only be worn outdoors and must be removed when entering the classroom.
- Hats, baseball caps, hoods, and sunglasses may not be worn in class.
- Interpretation of dress code violations is at the discretion of the school administration.
- Students in violation of the school uniform and dress code policy may be withheld admission into their classroom until their parent or guardian provides them with acceptable uniform items.

ELEMENTARY (K-5TH GRADE)

GIRLS

CHAPEL UNIFORM

TOPS: White collared button-down oxford shirt (long sleeve or short sleeve), tucked in. All dress shirts must be buttoned and may not be worn as a loose layer over T-shirts or camisole-style garments. (Some examples listed below in the “Regular Uniform” section.)

BOTTOMS: Land’s End clear blue plaid jumper or clear blue plaid skirt (various styles). Length of skirt/jumper must be at or below the knee. (Some examples listed below in the “Regular Uniform” section.)

OUTERWEAR: Monogrammed Land’s End outerwear jacket or sweater, TCS sweatshirt with monogram. No hooded sweatshirts during chapel service.

LEGWEAR & SHOES: White or navy blue ankle socks, knee socks, leggings, or tights. Dark closed toe dress shoes, (low heels optional for girls in grades 3-12).

NOTE: Chapel clothes should be pressed as needed. Teacher may request students bring a regular uniform change of clothes and shoes for after chapel.

REGULAR UNIFORM

TOPS:

Style: Polo or Blouse (short or long sleeve)

Color Choice: Polo: cobalt blue, classic navy, white, maize; Blouse: white

Examples: Lands’ End Uniforms

- Long Sleeve Performance Interlock Polo Shirt
- Short Sleeve Solid Performance Mesh Polo Shirt
- Kids' Long Sleeve Solid Performance Mesh Polo Shirt
- Girls' Long Sleeve Ruffle Collar Peter Pan Knit Top
- Girls' Long Sleeve Ruffle Collar Peter Pan Knit Top
- Girls' Short Sleeve Peter Pan Ruffle Front Knit Polo

Notes:

- All shirt tails should be tucked in.
- All dress shirts and polo shirts must be buttoned and may not be worn as a loose layer over T-shirts or camisole-style garments.
- Long sleeve plain t-shirt or turtle-neck in school colors may be worn under long sleeve school uniform top or jumper

BOTTOMS:

Style: Jumper, Dress, Skirt, Pants or Shorts

Color Choices: Jumper/Dress/Skirt: clear blue plaid, classic navy or khaki; Pants/Shorts: Classic Navy, Khaki

- Girls' Plaid Pleated Side Buckle Jumper
- Girls' Side Pleat Solid Blended Jumper
- Girls' Plaid Side Button Kilt Skirt
- Girls' Regular Uniform Pleated Plaid Skirt

- Girls' Pleat Front Iron Knee® Blend Chino Pants
- Girls' Iron Knee® Elastic Waist Blend Chino Pants
- Girls' Plain Front Blend Chino Shorts

- Girls' Stain Resistant Stretch Crop Pants

Notes:

- Bike shorts or leggings must be worn under skirts and jumpers by girls in grades K-5.
- All hemlines must not be shorter than 3” above the knee.

- No cargo pants or shorts

OUTERWEAR:

Style: Jackets or Sweaters

Color Choices: Jackets: classic navy or cobalt blue; Sweaters: classic navy or cobalt blue or maize

Examples:

- Lands' End School Uniform Girls' T-200 Fleece Jacket
- School Uniform Fine Gauge Cotton Cardigan Sweater
- School Uniform Girls' Button-front Drifter Cardigan Sweater
- School Uniform Girls' T-200 Fleece Jacket
- School Uniform Girls' Long Sleeve Performance Fine Gauge Cardigan

Notes:

- School logo monogram is required on all outerwear; Monogram is available through Land's End or school-approved vendor.

SHOES/SOCKS/BELTS:

- White or navy blue ankle socks, crew socks, knee socks, leggings, or tights. All students must wear socks
- Rubber-soled, closed toe dress shoes, sneakers or athletic shoes; (no sandals, flip flops, crocks, jellies, or boots). All footwear should complement dress code; reflect modesty and moderation, and keep students safe.
- Coordinating belt (dark blue, black, brown) with small buckle to be worn with pants/shorts with belt loops.

PE UNIFORM (4th-12th GRADES ONLY)

TOPS: Plain t-shirt or school t-shirt in gray (long or short sleeve). Shirt should be loose fitting. Athletic sweatshirts in cobalt blue, navy, or gray may be worn over PE clothes on cold weather days.

BOTTOMS: Athletic shorts in navy blue or cobalt blue. Shorts are to fit appropriately around the legs and properly around the waist. Hemline should be no shorter than 3" above the knee. Biker shorts must be worn underneath shorts if not long enough. Athletic sweatpants in cobalt blue, navy, or gray may be worn over PE clothes on cold weather days.

LEGWEAR & SHOES: Athletic shoes that support physical activity and white or navy socks are required.

NOTES: Small/modest/light jewelry is acceptable if it does not interfere with activity. Girls should wear hair back during P.E.

FRIDAY UNIFORM

TOPS: Regular school uniform shirts, Christian T-shirts, School Spirit Shirts, or plain T-shirts

BOTTOMS: Regular school uniform shorts or pants, Blue Jean pants (No Blue Jean Shorts, athletic shorts, or cargo shorts). Regular school uniform jumper or skirts

LEGWEAR & SHOES: White or navy blue ankle socks, knee socks, leggings, or tights. All students should wear socks. Rubber-soled, closed toe dress shoes; sneakers or athletic shoes; (no sandals, flip flops, crocks or jellies). All footwear should complement dress code; reflect modesty and moderation, and keep students safe.

NOTES: Friday students are welcome to bring a change of clothes for the afternoon outdoor games and activities (See P.E. Dress Code)

GROOMING & JEWELRY

- Neatly styled hair, natural hair coloring; highlights or hair color only in natural hair colors
- Bows, ribbons, or headbands should coordinate with uniform and not distract from well-groomed appearance
- No visible tattoos or body piercings, except single pierced ears for girls
- Nails may be painted in non-distracting, conservative colors only

BOYS***CHAPEL UNIFORM***

TOPS: White button-down oxford style dress shirt (long sleeve or short sleeve) tucked in and solid navy neck tie or bow tie. Ties optional for boys in grades K-5.

BOTTOMS: Navy slacks with black or dark blue belt with small buckle. Students in grades K-5 may wear navy dress shorts with black or dark blue belt. (Belt to be worn if pants/shorts have belt loops). No suspenders.

OUTERWEAR: Monogrammed Land's End outerwear jacket or sweater, TCS sweatshirt with monogram. No hooded sweatshirts during chapel service.

LEGWEAR & SHOES: Dark socks, dark dress shoes.

NOTE: Chapel clothes should be pressed as needed. Long sleeves may be rolled up appropriately and ties may be loosened appropriately after chapel service. Teacher may request students bring a regular uniform change of clothes and shoes for after chapel

REGULAR UNIFORMTOPS:

Style: Polo or Dress Shirt (short or long sleeve)

Color Choice: Polo: cobalt blue, classic navy, white, maize; Dress Shirt: white

Examples: Lands' End Uniforms

- Short Sleeve Solid Performance Interlock Polo Shirt
- Long Sleeve Performance Interlock Polo Shirt
- Short Sleeve Solid Performance Mesh Polo Shirt
- Kids' Long Sleeve Solid Performance Mesh Polo Shirt

Notes:

- All shirt tails should be tucked in.
- Long sleeve plain t-shirt or turtle-neck in school colors may be worn under long sleeve school uniform top

BOTTOMS:

Style: Pants or Shorts

Color Choices: classic navy or khaki

Examples: Lands' End Uniforms

- Boys' Plain Front Iron Knee® Stain & Wrinkle Resistant
- Chino Pants Boys' Pleat Front Iron Knee® Stain & Wrinkle Resistant Chino Pants
- Boys' Plain Front Stain & Wrinkle Resistant Chino Shorts
- Boys' Pleat Front Chino Shorts

Notes:

- No cargo pants or shorts

OUTERWEAR:

Style: Jackets or Sweaters

Color Choices: Jackets: classic navy or cobalt blue; Sweaters: classic navy or cobalt blue or maize

Examples:

- Boys' T-200 Fleece Jacket
- Boys' Zip-front Drifter Cardigan Sweater
- Boys' Button-front Drifter Cardigan Sweater
- Boys' Drifter V-neck Sweater
- Boys' Drifter Sweater Vest
- TCS crewneck sweatshirt
- TCS hooded zip-up sweatshirt

Notes:

- School logo monogram is required on all outerwear; Monogram is available through Land's End or school-approved vendor.

SHOES/SOCKS/BELTS:

- White or navy blue ankle socks, crew socks, or knee socks. All students must wear socks.
- Rubber-soled, closed toe dress shoes, sneakers or athletic shoes; (no sandals, flip flops, crocks, jellies, or boots). All footwear should complement dress code; reflect modesty and moderation, and keep students safe.
- Coordinating belt (dark blue, black, brown) with small buckle to be worn with pants/shorts with belt loops.

PE UNIFORM (4th-12th GRADES ONLY)

TOPS: Plain t-shirt or school t-shirt in gray (long or short sleeve). Shirt should be loose fitting. Athletic sweatshirts in cobalt blue, navy, or gray may be worn over PE clothes on cold weather days.

BOTTOMS: Athletic shorts in navy blue or cobalt blue. Shorts are to fit appropriately around the legs and properly around the waist. Athletic sweatpants in cobalt blue, navy, or gray may be worn over PE clothes on cold weather days.

LEGWEAR & SHOES: Athletic shoes that support physical activity and white or navy socks are required.

NOTES: Small/modest/light jewelry is acceptable if it does not interfere with activity.

FRIDAY UNIFORM

TOPS: Regular school uniform shirts, Christian T-shirts, School Spirit Shirts, or plain T-shirts

BOTTOMS: Regular school uniform shorts or pants, Blue Jean pants (No Blue Jean Shorts, athletic shorts, or cargo shorts).

LEGWEAR & SHOES: White or navy blue ankle socks or knee socks. All students must wear socks. Rubber-soled, closed toe dress shoes; sneakers or athletic shoes; (no sandals, flip flops, crocks or boots). GROOMING & JEWELRY

- Hair must be combed and styled neatly and appropriately
- Hair must be trimmed above the ear and above the eyebrows, not to reach below the collar of a dress shirt.
- Faces should be clean shaven; no beard, mustache, or stubble; sideburns must not extend below mid ear
- No visible tattoos or body piercings

JUNIOR HIGH (6TH-8TH GRADE)

GIRLS

CHAPEL UNIFORM

TOPS: White collared button-down oxford shirt (long sleeve or short sleeve), tucked in. All dress shirts must be buttoned and may not be worn as a loose layer over T-shirts or camisole-style garments. (Some examples listed below in the “Regular Uniform” section.)

BOTTOMS: Land’s End clear blue plaid jumper or clear blue plaid skirt (various styles). Length of skirt/jumper must be at or below the knee. (Some examples listed below in the “Regular Uniform” section.)

OUTERWEAR: Monogrammed Land’s End outerwear jacket or sweater, TCS sweatshirt with monogram. No hooded sweatshirts during chapel service.

LEGWEAR & SHOES: White or navy blue ankle socks, knee socks, leggings, or tights. Dark closed toe dress shoes, (low heels optional for girls in grades 3-12).

NOTE: Chapel clothes should be pressed as needed.

REGULAR UNIFORM

Style: Polo or Blouse (short or long sleeve)

Color Choice: Polo: cobalt blue, classic navy, white, maize; Blouse: white

- Long sleeve plain t-shirt or turtle-neck in school colors may be worn under long sleeve school uniform top or jumper

BOTTOMS:

Style: Jumper, Dress, Skirt, Pants, Shorts, Jean Pants (appropriately fitting, no designs, rips or fraying)

Color Choices: Jumper/Dress/Skirt: clear blue plaid, classic navy or khaki; Pants/Shorts: Classic Navy, Khaki

- Coordinating belt (dark blue, black, brown) with small buckle to be worn with pants/shorts with belt loops.

PE UNIFORM (4th-12th GRADES ONLY)

TOPS: Plain t-shirt or school t-shirt in gray (long or short sleeve). Shirt should be loose fitting. Athletic sweatshirts in cobalt blue, navy, or gray may be worn over PE clothes on cold weather days.

BOTTOMS: Athletic shorts in navy blue or cobalt blue. Shorts are to fit appropriately around the legs and properly around the waist. Hemline should be no shorter than 3" above the knee. Biker shorts must be worn underneath shorts if not long enough. Athletic sweatpants in cobalt blue, navy, or gray may be worn over PE clothes on cold weather days.

LEGWEAR & SHOES: Athletic shoes that support physical activity and white or navy socks are required.

NOTES: Small/modest/light jewelry is acceptable if it does not interfere with activity. Girls should wear hair back during P.E.

FRIDAY UNIFORM

TOPS: Regular school uniform shirts, Christian T-shirts, School Spirit Shirts, or plain T-shirts

BOTTOMS: Regular school uniform shorts or pants, Blue Jean pants (No Blue Jean Shorts, athletic shorts, or cargo shorts). Regular school uniform jumper or skirts

LEGWEAR & SHOES: White or navy blue ankle socks, knee socks, leggings, or tights. All students must wear socks when not wearing sandals. Rubber-soled, closed toe dress shoes (2 inch heels or less), sneakers, athletic shoes, supportive sandals, dress boots; (no string sandals, flip flops, crocks, jellies, or combat boots, work boots, or house shoes). All footwear should complement dress code; reflect modesty and moderation, and keep students safe.

LEGWEAR & SHOES: Dark socks, dark dress shoes.

NOTE: Chapel clothes should be pressed as needed. Long sleeves may be rolled up appropriately and ties may be loosened appropriately after chapel service.

REGULAR UNIFORMTOPS:

Style: Polo or Dress Shirt (short or long sleeve)

Color Choice: Polo: cobalt blue, classic navy, white, maize; Dress Shirt: white

Examples: Lands' End Uniforms

- Short Sleeve Solid Performance Interlock Polo Shirt
- Long Sleeve Performance Interlock Polo Shirt
- Short Sleeve Solid Performance Mesh Polo Shirt
- Kids' Long Sleeve Solid Performance Mesh Polo Shirt

Notes:

- Polo shirt tails should be tucked in when appropriate. Button-down shirt tails must be tucked in
- Long sleeve plain t-shirt or turtle-neck in school colors may be worn under long sleeve school uniform top

BOTTOMS:

Style: Pants, Shorts, Jean Pants (appropriately fitting, no designs, rips or fraying)

Color Choices: Pants/Shorts: Classic Navy, Khaki; Jeans: Dark or light denim

- Chino Pants Boys' Pleat Front Iron Knee® Stain & Wrinkle Resistant Chino Pants

HIGH SCHOOL (9TH-12TH GRADE)

GIRLS

CHAPEL UNIFORM

TOPS: White collared button-down oxford shirt (long sleeve or short sleeve), tucked in. All dress shirts must be buttoned and may not be worn as a loose layer over T-shirts or camisole-style garments. (Some examples listed below in the “Regular Uniform” section.)

BOTTOMS: Land’s End clear blue plaid jumper or clear blue plaid skirt (various styles). Length of skirt/jumper must be at or below the knee. (Some examples listed below in the “Regular Uniform” section.)

OUTERWEAR: Monogrammed Land’s End outerwear jacket or sweater, TCS sweatshirt with monogram. No hooded sweatshirts during chapel service.

LEGWEAR & SHOES: White or navy blue ankle socks, knee socks, leggings, or tights. Dark closed toe dress shoes, (low heels optional for girls in grades 3-12).

NOTE: Chapel clothes should be pressed as needed.

REGULAR UNIFORM

TOPS:

Style: Polo or Blouse (short or long sleeve)

Color Choice: Personal choice of color for polo and dress shirts (no designs, imprints, or logos other than school logo)

Examples: Lands’ End Uniforms

- Short Sleeve Solid Performance Interlock Polo Shirt
- Long Sleeve Performance Interlock Polo Shirt
- Short Sleeve Solid Performance Mesh Polo Shirt
- Kids' Long Sleeve Solid Performance Mesh Polo Shirt
- Girls' Long Sleeve Ruffle Collar Peter Pan Knit Top
- Girls' Long Sleeve Ruffle Collar Peter Pan Knit Top
- Girls' Short Sleeve Peter Pan Ruffle Front Knit Polo

Notes:

- Shirt tails should be tucked in when appropriate
- All dress shirts and polo shirts must be buttoned and may not be worn as a loose layer over T-shirts or camisole-style garments.
- Long sleeve plain t-shirt or turtle-neck in school colors may be worn under long sleeve school uniform top or jumper

BOTTOMS:

Style: Jumper, Dress, Skirt, Pants, Shorts, Jean Pants (appropriately fitting, no designs, rips or fraying)

Color Choices: Jumper/Dress/Skirt: clear blue plaid, classic navy or khaki; Pants/Shorts: Classic Navy, Khaki

- Rubber-soled, closed toe dress shoes (2 inch heels or less), sneakers, athletic shoes, supportive sandals, dress boots; (no string sandals, flip flops, crocks, jellies, or combat boots, work boots, or house shoes). - Coordinating belt (dark blue, black, brown) with small buckle to be worn with pants/shorts with belt loops.

PE UNIFORM (4th-12th GRADES ONLY)

TOPS: Plain t-shirt or school t-shirt in gray (long or short sleeve). Shirt should be loose fitting. Athletic sweatshirts in cobalt blue, navy, or gray may be worn over PE clothes on cold weather days.

BOTTOMS: Athletic shorts in navy blue or cobalt blue. Shorts are to fit appropriately around the legs and properly around the waist. Hemline should be no shorter than 3" above the knee. Biker shorts must be worn underneath shorts if not long enough. Athletic sweatpants in cobalt blue, navy, or gray may be worn over PE clothes on cold weather days.

LEGWEAR & SHOES: Athletic shoes that support physical activity and white or navy socks are required.

NOTES: Small/modest/light jewelry is acceptable if it does not interfere with activity. Girls should wear hair back during P.E.

FRIDAY UNIFORM

TOPS: Regular school uniform shirts, Christian T-shirts, School Spirit Shirts, or plain T-shirts

BOTTOMS: Regular school uniform shorts or pants, Blue Jean pants (No Blue Jean Shorts, athletic shorts, or cargo shorts). Regular school uniform jumper or skirts

LEGWEAR & SHOES: White or navy blue ankle socks, knee socks, leggings, or tights. All students must wear socks when not wearing sandals. Rubber-soled, closed toe dress shoes (2 inch heels or less), sneakers, athletic shoes, supportive sandals, dress boots; (no string sandals, flip flops, crocks, jellies, or combat boots, work boots, or house shoes). All footwear should complement dress code; reflect modesty and moderation, and keep students safe.

NOTES: Friday students are welcome to bring a change of clothes for the afternoon outdoor games and activities (See P.E. Dress Code)

GROOMING & JEWELRY

- Neatly styled hair, natural hair coloring; highlights or hair color only in natural hair colors
- Bows, ribbons, or headbands should coordinate with uniform and not distract from well-groomed appearance
- No visible tattoos or body piercings, except single pierced ears for girls
- Nails may be painted in non-distracting, conservative colors only

BOYS***CHAPEL UNIFORM***

TOPS: White button-down oxford style dress shirt (long sleeve or short sleeve) tucked in and solid navy neck tie or bow tie.

BOTTOMS: Navy slacks with black or dark blue belt with small buckle. No suspenders.

OUTERWEAR: Monogrammed Land's End outerwear jacket or sweater, TCS sweatshirt with monogram. No hooded sweatshirts during chapel service.

LEGWEAR & SHOES: Dark socks, dark dress shoes.

NOTE: Chapel clothes should be pressed as needed. Long sleeves may be rolled up appropriately and ties may be loosened appropriately after chapel service.

Style: Pants, Shorts, Jean Pants (appropriately fitting, no designs, rips or fraying)

Color Choices: Pants/Shorts: Classic Navy, Khaki; Jeans: Dark or light denim
