Witnessing the body of Christ serve in unity after Hurricane Harvey has been truly amazing. This event has been a reminder of the importance of equipping the next generation to be the hands and feet of Christ to wherever God calls them. The Connection School's mission is to partner with parents to disciple a generation to love God with all of their hearts, souls, and minds and to love others as they love themselves. After the goal of 100% TCS family participation is met, the Advancement Team will be in an optimal position to move forward with plans to share the vision and partnership opportunities with others.

The 2017/2018 Annual Fund is the primary fundraiser this year for TCS families in lieu of a golf tournament or other similar fundraisers. We will be hosting a spring fundraiser as well as offering other opportunities to share the mission of our school with those outside the immediate TCS family.
